Dates: Saturday, 30 May 2009 4-Position Service Rifle Match, Slow Fire

Saturday, 30 May 2009 CMP Garand-Springfield-Vintage Military Rifle (G-S-M) Match

Sunday, 31 May 2009 National Match Course (NMC), Service Rifle

Saturday, 29 August 2009 National Match Course(NMC), Service Rifle

Saturday, 29 August 2009 CMP Garand-Springfield-Vintage Military Rifle (G-S-M) Match

Sunday, 30 August 2009 Bullseye Match, Service Pistol

Time: Registration and squadding at 0700 each day. Firing for the first match of the day commences at 0800. The

G-S-M matches will commence immediately following the completion of the first match of the day.

Location: All matches will be held at the New York National Guard Training Site Rifle Range, Grant Hill Road, Guilderland NY.

Eligibility: Match is open to all Marine Corps League members and associate members in good standing, and to guests of the

Department of New York. Entry preference will be given to members of the Department of New York.

Entry Fees: June matches: \$50.00 for all three matches; two matches, \$40.00; one match \$25.00.

August matches: \$40.00 for all three matches; two matches, \$30.00; one match \$20.00.

Rifles/Sights: For Slow-FireMatch and NMC: U.S. military rifles in original configuration with iron sights (sporterized rifles

not allowed). Rifles permitted are the U.S. Rifle, Caliber .30, M1 (Garand); U.S. Rifle, Caliber 7.62mm, M14; U.S. Rifle, Caliber 5.56mm, M16; Caliber .30 U.S. Model 1903 Springfield Rifle; Caliber .30 U.S. Model 1917 Rifle (Enfield); Caliber .30 M1941 Johnson rifle; U.S. Krag rifle; and and U.S. Carbine Caliber .30 M1 and their commercial equivalents. Stocks must be standard military-issue wood or synthetic material stocks or similar stocks of commercial manufacture. Slings must be standard-issue leather or web slings or similar slings of

commercial manufacture.

For G-S-M matches: U.S. military rifles in "as-issued" condition, including: Caliber .30 U.S. Model 1903 Springfield rifle series; Caliber .30 U.S. Model 1917 rifle; Caliber .30 U.S. M1 Garand rifle; Caliber .30 M1941 Iohnson rifle; U.S. Krag rifle; and U.S. Carbine Caliber .30 M1. – or – "As-Issued" Foreign Military Rifle

issued by the armed forces of a country other than the U.S. in "as-issued" condition.

Pistols/Sights: U.S. military and similar pistols and revolvers with iron sights (optical sights are not allowed).

Ammunition: All competitors must supply their own ammunition. Ball ammunition only for rifles, ball or semi-wadcutters for

pistols and revolvers. Armor piercing, tracer and incendiary rounds are prohibited.

Awards: All competitors at the June matches will receive a commemorative embroidered patch. A trophy plaque will be

awarded to the Grand Champion (top overall aggregate score) for each tournament. Trophy plaques for rifle will be awarded to the Match Winner in the 4-Position Slow Fire Match; to the Match Winner, to the 1st Expert, 1st Sharpshooter and 1st Marksman, and to the 1st-place team in the National Match Course. For the G-S-M matches, shooters who equal or exceed CMP-established scores in these matches will earn gold, silver or bronze Achievement Pins commissioned by the CMP. Trophy plaques will be awarded for the Bullseye Pistol Course to

the Match Winner, to the 1st-place 2-person team, and to the 1st-place 4-person team.

Courses of Fire:

4-Position Rifle Match, Slow Fire - This match is fired from 200 yards on the NRA SR target.

Stage 1: 10 shots, slow fire, standing, 10 minutes Stage 2: 10 shots, slow fire, kneeling, 10 minutes Stage 3: 10 shots, slow fire, sitting, 10 minutes Stage 4: 10 shots, slow fire, prone, 10 minutes

National Match Course, Rifle

Stage 1: 10 shots, slow fire, standing, 10 minutes, 200 yards (NRA SR target)

Stage 2: 10 shots, rapid fire, sitting or kneeling from standing, 60 seconds, 200 yards (NRA SR target)

Stage 3: 10 shots, rapid fire, prone from standing, 70 seconds, 200 yards (NRA SR-42 target)

Stage 4: 20 shots, slow fire, prone, 20 minutes, 200 yards (NRA MR-52 target)

Garand-Springfield-Vintage Military Rifle Match - This match is fired from 200 yards on the NRA SR target. Coaching is allowed.

Sighters: 5 shots, slow fire, any position(15 minutes combined for sighters *plus* Stage 1) Stage 1: 10 shots, slow fire, prone (15 minutes combined for sighters *plus* Stage 1)

Stage 2: 10 shots, rapid fire, prone from standing, 80 seconds

Stage 3: 10 shots, slow fire, standing, 10 minutes

Bullseye Match, Pistol - The entire match is fired from 25 yards on the NRA B-8 target. Thie entire course is fired twice.

Stage 1: Two strings of 5 shots each, slow fire, 5 minutes Stage 2: Two strings of 5 shots each, timed fire, 20 seconds Stage 3: Two strings of 5 shots each, rapid fire, 10 seconds

Competitor's Equipment: Shooting jacket, ground mat, shooting glove, kit or stool, and spotting scope are recommended. Open-bolt indicators are mandatory (available at the match).

Team Entries: A rifle team consists of five (5) shooters. Teams consisting of four shooters may enter competition by accepting a "blind score" for the fifth shooter. A Detachment may enter more than one team, but only one team from each Detachment may be entered in the Postal Match. For Pistol, two- and four-person teams may be entered.

National Marine Corps League Postal Match: The scores fired in the National Match Course (Rifle) and the Bullseye Pistol matches may be submitted for entry in the National Postal Match (additional fees apply).

Directions: Follow the New York State Thruway to Exit 24 - Albany. Take the first exit for US 20/Western Avenue (this puts you southbound on the Adirondack Northway). Continue for .5 miles to the end of the highway. Turn right onto Western Avenue/US 20 (West), and proceed for 3.7 miles to the traffic light at Foundry Road. Turn left, proceed .6 miles and bear right on Grant Hill Road. Continue for .6 miles. After crossing the steel deck bridge, turn right through the gate into the Training Site.

Facilities: There is ample parking for cars and RVs (no hookups or waste dump), and a bivouac area for tents. No potable water is available at the site, but showers and rest rooms are available. You are advised to bring toilet paper, plenty of drinking water, insect repellent, a flashlight, and food and beverages. *Please note: There will be no break for lunch during the conduct of the matches*. This is a military site and no alcoholic beverages are permitted on the grounds. For those who prefer lodgings offsite, there are several motels and restaurants a short distance from the range.
